Coach Code of Conduct

All BoniVital Minor Baseball Association (BVMBA) coaches will govern themselves according to the following Code of Conduct, which includes but is not limited to the following:

Definition - Coaches - Head Coach and/or assistant coach

- Coaches are committed to the team for the entire season and the duration of playoffs.
- Coaches will arrive prepared and on time to all games and practices.
- Coaches will treat each player fairly.
- ➤ Coaches will respect the players, parents, opponents, officials, and program administrators.
- > Coaches will not ridicule, embarrass, demean, or abuse any player, spectator, official, or opponent.
- Coaches will refrain from the use of profanity, insulting, harassing or otherwise offensive language.
- Coaches will not provide alcohol, tobacco (in any form), or any illegal substances for player use.
- Coaches will respect any academic commitments players have and ensure that their activities permit them to pursue academic success.
- Coaches will ensure that any activity being undertaken is suitable for the age, experience, ability and fitness level of the players.
- Coaches will consider the future health and well-being as foremost when making decisions regarding an injured player's ability to continue training or competing.
- Coaches will abide by the rules and regulations of Baseball Manitoba, WABA, and any other organization which regulates gameplay.
- Coaches will respect the rules of each field where they play, the property of the association at all times and make every attempt to prevent damage of said property.
- Coaches will regularly seek ways of increasing personal development and ensure their coaching certification is current.
 - Required certification for the highest level of competition possible for the season including all post season play, must be completed by June 1st of the baseball season.
- Coaches will conduct themselves in an honest and respectful manner on and off the field while representing BoniVital Minor Baseball Association.
- Coaches will wear their BoniVital Baseball jersey when provided or acceptable/approved attire during all games or events of competition with pride, and will project a favorable image of BVMBA.
 - Approved attire includes baseball or athletic pants, athletic running shoes.
 - o Jeans, shorts, sandals, tank top are not approved coaching attire.
