AAA uniform policy

Approved Uniform and Colours

The approved Bonivital uniform is jersey, pants, belt, socks and hat. The colors are black, yellow and white. White pants and a black belt must be worn by each player and coach. Socks must be worn in length that corresponds with chosen pant length with chosen color being yellow or black only. Jerseys shall be yellow and black.

All players and coaches are required to wear a black or yellow shirt under the black jersey. The coach shall determine the color of the shirt required to be worn. All players must wear the same color of shirt under the black jersey. An undershirt is not required to be worn under the yellow jersey.

Black shall be the only permissible color of long-sleeved shirt worn under a jersey. Short-sleeved shirts will be either black or yellow. Black shirts worn under a jersey must not have any logos or print visible above the collar or below the sleeves. Sponsorship logos are not accepted, but manufacturer's logos are acceptable.

Players and coaches shall wear the appropriate colored jersey for each game. The Bonivital Board will determine the colour of the home and away jersey at the start of each season. The exception to this rule is that home and away game jerseys can only be changed at the discretion of the coach or to comply with rules of any tournament.

Uniform Assigned Player Numbers

All player numbers will be assigned by the Vice-President of High Performance, Bonivital Baseball. Players shall maintain the assigned number for each consecutive AAA season. Switching numbers with other players is only permitted at the discretion of the Vice-President of High Performance.

Uniform Supplier

Players are required to purchase their own uniforms. Jerseys must contain the Bonivital Baseball assigned number. Jerseys and the yellow short-sleeved undershirts must be purchased from the Bonivital board-approved vendor. Purchase of pants, belt, socks and black undershirts from the approved vendor is not required.

Bonivital shall provide each player and coach with a baseball hat with Board-approved branding. Bonivital shall supply each coach with the approved jersey.

Lost, Damaged or Inappropriate Sized Uniforms

Players and coaches are required to repair and maintain their own uniforms. All uniforms must be neat, free from tears and appropriately sized for the player. Uniform size must not interfere

with the ability to play the game. Where the jersey(s) is damaged or no longer presentable, nor appropriate for game play, the player is required to repair or replace it at their own expense.

Motion by John to accept jersey policy as amended. Jeff and Curtis seconded.

Motion by Jeff to accept jersey as designed for 2018. Seconded by Wayne. Motion accepted.

- i. Process to determine number of teams at any AA level
 - Motion made by John that if there are more than 30 players registered at AA tryouts at any level, then Bonivital will select 2 AA teams for such level. Seconded by Wayne. All in favour.
- ii. Process for team formation for 2 AA teams
 - Motion made by John that f two teams are being formed, teams will be selected based upon their year of birth (YOB) to form a "1st year" and a "2nd year" team in each age group. Once the 2nd year coach has selected a team comprised of all players of the 2nd YOB, the 1st year coach can then select the top 1st year players and also select any remaining 2nd year players that ranged in the top 20. The 1st year team must select 70% of 1st year players in order to help develop the players. If there are insufficient players in 2nd years, tryout committee will convene to set policy to complete teams. Seconded by Curtis. Jeff opposes. Motion passed.
